

Dream Collection Categories

If you were to build your dream collection, what categories would it include? Here are some questions to help you narrow down what categories you like to focus on....

1. What denominations do you collect?

Example: Five cents from every year, coloured \$2 coins, all special designs that go into circulation, pre-decimal coins, coins from other countries.

2. What themes do you collect?

Example: ANZAC, particular sports, a specific animal, planets and space, dinosaurs, royal events, Bluey, Star Wars, Batman, Marvel Superheroes, or other pop-culture.

3. Do you collect coins with a specific composition?

Example: Silver or gold.

4. What formats do you collect?

Example: Sets, PNCs, rolls, graded slabs and/or single coins

5. Are there any ongoing series you collect?

Example: Perth Mint's 'Great Southern Land' series, the RAM's annual Baby Coins sets.

6. Are there any completable sets you collect?

Example: The 50c/20c set from 2001 Federation series.

7. If you collect graded coins, are you after a particular grade?

Example: All coins must be MS67 or better.

8. Do you collect mintmarks, privy marks or counter-stamps?

Example: Coloured \$2 coins with C-mintmarks, sets with the various ANDA privy marks.

9. Are there any errors and/or varieties you like to collect?

Example: \$1 coins with 'rabbit ears' from as many years as possible, or 2001 Federation \$1 coins with different rotation angles.

10. Given the information above, what are your favourite categories to focus on?

Examples:

- All special design coins from circulation
- ANZAC-themed PNCs
- Every coin with a poppy on it
- Graded 50c coins with a grade of MS67 (or higher)
- Every coloured \$2 coin with a C-Mintmark
- A roll of 5c coins from every possible year
- An annual set from every year
- Coins from the countries you've traveled to
